RULES

1. Entry fees and deposits are non refundable. Entries are subject to event coordinators review and approval.
2. Three people per team, two must be under the age of 17 as of May 24th, 2009. Proof of age may be required. Young Anglers must have written parental consent from both parents and /or guardians in order to be eligible to fish.
3. All Federal and Provincial fishing, boating and criminal laws must be obeyed at all times, anyone caught breaking these regulations may be disqualified. (Conservation Fishing License is not acceptable for Boater)
4. Registration and rules review will take place at the main dock in Palmer Park at 7:00AM
5. Fishing hours will be from 8:30AM – 3:30PM starting by a trickle start. Any team arriving late may be disqualified.
6. You must have an operating live well.
7. Livewell and kill switch operation inspection will take place from 7:45AM – 8:15AM at the main dock and every team’s boat must be operational.
8. Limit of 5 fish (walleye or panfish), of which only 3 of which may be walleye with only 1 walleye exceeding 18 inches.
9. Dead fish will be penalized 4 oz.
10. Zero tolerance for unsportsmanlike conduct, alcohol or illegal drug use. Disqualification may result without refund.
11. Prizes will be awarded in order of the teams heaviest weight overall. In the case of a tie, the team’s heaviest fish will determine the winner.
12. All participants must wear an approved floatation devise at all times on the water during the event.
13. No fishing within 100 yards of a MNR net.
14. No locking allowed.
15. Identification numbers must be affixed on motor, outside windshield or upper transom and made clearly visible.
16. Boaters must maintain 50 yards of another competitor’s boat.
17. If in need of fuel or washroom facilities one competitor is to remain with the boat at all times.
18. You MUST report to check in at end of the day. Any boats arriving after allowed time will be penalized 1 lb per minute.
19. If in case of extreme weather or state of emergency the event may be delayed, rescheduled or cancelled.
20. Boats must be 14’ or greater, canoes are not permitted.
21. Horsepower limits are based on vessel plate ratings and may not be exceeded.
22. All motors must have a working kill switch which must be worn when the outboard is running.
23. Every team must make themselves available for a group photo at the end of the tournament.
24. In order to be eligible for prizes each team must return and report to the main stage by no later than 4:30 .
25. Following the BBQ at approximately 4:30PM, the prizes will be awarded.
26. No refunds will be provided if disqualified.
27. Tournament Official rulings are final.
